

Nordplus – Nordic and Baltic collaboration in education sector – a holistic approach

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
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Nordplus is the Nordic Council of Ministers' mobility and networking programme for collaboration on education in the Nordic and Baltic countries.

Nordplus covers the five Nordic countries: Sweden, Norway, Denmark, Finland and Iceland, the three Baltic countries: Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania and the three autonomous regions: Åland, the Faroe Islands and Greenland.






Nordplus – promoting Lifelong and Lifewide Learning approach

Nordplus is the largest of the Nordic – Baltic educational cooperation initiatives, offering financial support for the collaboration between education institutions within the entire field of education –

- from kindergarten and primary education to higher education and adult learning, covering formal and non-formal, general and vocational education activities.





Main objectives of Nordplus 2018 – 2022

- To strengthen and develop Nordic educational cooperation and contribute to the establishment of a **Nordic-Baltic educational region**;
- To support, develop, draw benefit from and disseminate innovative products and processes in education through the systematic exchange of experiences and best practice;
- To contribute to the development of quality and innovation in the educational systems for lifelong learning in the participating countries by means of educational cooperation, as well as cooperating with workplaces, about development projects, exchanges and building of networks;
- To promote Nordic languages and culture, as well as mutual Nordic-Baltic linguistic and cultural understanding;
- Strengthen the **language comprehension** for the Nordic languages, especially among children and youth, primarily for Danish, Swedish and Norwegian;
- Encourage the interest in, knowledge of, and understanding of the Nordic languages.






 About 10 million euro is available for grants each year;



- About 600 applications per year, about
 400 of them are approved for funding;
- About 9,000 participants of mobilities each year – students, teachers, adult learners participating in exchange with another Nordic-Baltic country;
- In the years **2012-2018**, Nordplus has received a total of 4821 applications, of which **3015** received funding.








Number of project applications in the period 2012-2018








Number of organisations applying in the period 2012-2018












